All appliances & electronics, including: air conditioners, computers, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, dryers, electronics, freezers, furnaces, microwaves, stoves, trash burners, TVs, water heaters, and water softeners (no salt).

Did you know?

Production of recycled paper uses 80% less water, 65% less energy and produces 95% less air pollution than paper production using raw materials.

Recycling aluminum uses 95% less energy than producing cans from new metal ore.

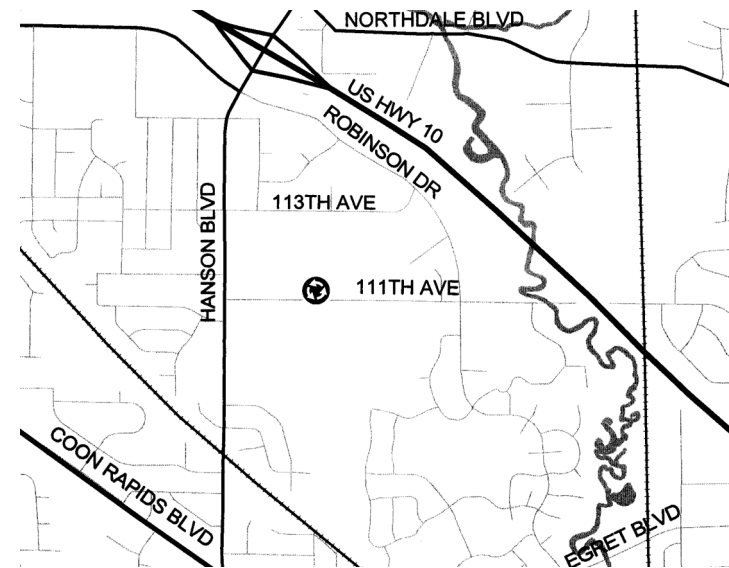
Glass recycling saves 25 to 32% of the energy used to make new glass and reduces related air pollution by 20% and water pollution by 50%.

Recycling 1 ton of plastic saves 685 gallons of oil.

Recycling in Coon Rapids

Curbside recycling is available to all residents living in single family homes, townhouses and condos. Apartment complexes set up recycling services through their garbage hauler.

A recycling drop-off center for residents is located at 1831 111th Ave NW (1 block east of Hanson Blvd).



Thank you for your continued recycling efforts.

Coon Rapids households average 596 pounds of recycling every year!

Please review the list of materials that can be recycled and recycle more if you can.

Curbside Collection of Recyclables

Set recyclables at the curb by 7 a.m. (same day as garbage pickup). Place recycling container at least 4 feet away from garbage can. Set the containers in the driveway off the street.

Containers are provided by the haulers. Call your hauler to obtain a container. Some haulers commingle recyclable materials; others have a single sort system. Call your hauler for specific information.

Do not place recyclables in plastic bags.

Aluminum Cans

Clothing – call your hauler, not all haulers accept

Glass – food/beverage, bottles & jars; rinse

Paper

- mail, office & school papers
- magazines & catalogs
- newspapers & inserts
- phone books
- shredded paper in closed paper bags
- cardboard boxes – flatten
- cereal, cracker, pasta & cake mix boxes
- shoe boxes, gift boxes & electronics boxes
- boxes from toothpaste, medications & other toiletries
- paper towel & toilet paper cores



Food Box Guidelines: Boxes from items meant to go in your cupboard (cereal, etc.) are generally recyclable. Packages for refrigerated and microwaveable products, such as frozen entrees, are usually coated in ways that make them unacceptable for recycling.

Plastic – #1 & #2 bottles & jugs with a neck & a screw-on lid; NO fertilizer, pesticide, chemical or automotive fluid containers; rinse & throw away lid

Steel Food Cans – rinse

Recycling Questions

For specific curbside recycling questions or a missed collection, call your hauler, hold items until your next recycling day or take them to the recycling center.

Place all materials in appropriate containers.

All materials collected curbside, same guidelines, plus:

Antifreeze – NO gasoline, solvents or oil mixed with antifreeze

Appliances – fee (**1st Saturday of the month only**)

Batteries – automotive

Batteries – household

Batteries – rechargeable

Bicycles

Books – hard cover, book paper will be tested

Carpet – fee, must load your own

Christmas Lights & Extension Cords

Clothing – used clothing & shoes only

Computers/Electronics/TVs – fee (**1st Saturday of the month only**)

Cell Phones

Eyeglasses

Fire Extinguishers – fee

Fluorescent Bulbs – Coon Rapids residents only, ID required; 5 free, do not tape together

Mattresses – fee (**1st Saturday of the month only 9:00 a.m. – noon**)

Packing Peanuts

Paper egg cartons

Plastic – All items must have recycling symbols and number. Unmarked items and any item larger than a 5 gallon bucket will NOT be accepted. #1, all shapes and sizes of plastic accepted, even clamshells; #2, all shapes and sizes; #3, all food containers, laundry, (NO PVC pipe, plumbing & conduit); #4, all lids, and food containers; #5, all plastic; #6, all plastic, CD cases, #7, all plastic

Plastic Bags – dry, no food residue; no rigid or rope handles, no black plastic

Pop & Beer Cases

Propane Tanks

Scrap Metal – remove all non-metal material

Styrofoam™ – Products; white foam cups, egg cartons, food trays, clam shells (must be clean)

Polystyrene – Rigid, block and shape packaging

Tires – fee

Used Oil – Coon Rapids residents only; NO gasoline, solvents or water, pour carefully into tank & take container home for reuse

Used Oil Filters – Coon Rapids residents only; NO business waste

Vegetable Oil – Vegetable based oils only, no grease, bacon grease or Crisco accepted.
