

### Did you know?

Production of recycled paper uses 80% less water, 65% less energy and produces 95% less air pollution than paper production using raw materials.

Recycling aluminum uses 95% less energy than producing cans from new metal ore.

Glass recycling saves 25 to 32% of the energy used to make new glass and reduces related air pollution by 20% and water pollution by 50%.

Recycling 1 ton of plastic saves 685 gallons of oil.

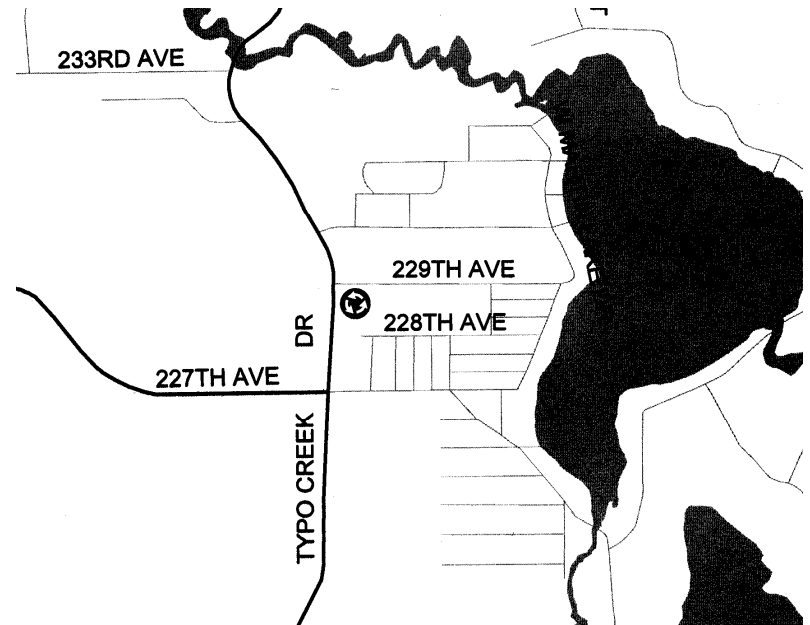

## Recycling in Linwood

Recycling is available to all residents living in single family homes. Set up recycling services through your garbage hauler.

A recycling drop-off center for residents is located at 22817 Typo Creek Dr NE.

Linwood households average 381 pounds of recycling every year!

Please review the list of materials that can be recycled and recycle more if you can.

## Curbside Collection of Recyclables

Set recyclables at the curb by 7 a.m. Place recycling container at least 4 feet away from garbage can. Pickup schedules vary by hauler but are at least twice per month. Call your hauler for your collection day.

*Do not place recyclables in plastic bags.*

### Aluminum Cans

**Aluminum Foil** – wipe off food debris

**Automotive Batteries** – call your hauler, not all haulers accept

**Clothing** – call your hauler, not all haulers accept

**Glass** – food/beverage, bottles & jars; rinse

### Paper

mail, office & school papers

magazines & catalogs

newspapers & inserts

phone books

shredded paper in closed paper bags

cardboard boxes – flatten

cereal, cracker, pasta & cake mix boxes

shoe boxes, gift boxes & electronics boxes

boxes from toothpaste, medications & other toiletries

paper towel & toilet paper cores



*Food Box Guidelines: Boxes from items meant to go in your cupboard (cereal, etc.) are generally recyclable. Packages for refrigerated and microwaveable products, such as frozen entrees, are usually coated in ways that make them unacceptable for recycling.*

**Plastic** – #1 & #2 bottles & jugs with a neck & a screw-on lid; NO fertilizer, pesticide, chemical or automotive fluid containers; rinse & throw away lid

**Steel Food Cans** – rinse

**Used Oil** – call your hauler, not all haulers accept

## Recycling Questions

For specific curbside recycling questions or a missed collection, call your hauler, hold items until your next recycling day or take them to the recycling center.

*Place all materials in appropriate containers.*

**All materials collected curbside**, same guidelines, plus;

**Antifreeze** – pour into barrel and take empty container with you.

**Scrap Metal** – remove all non-metal material

**Used Oil** – NO gasoline, solvents or water; pour carefully into tank & take container home for reuse

**Used Oil Filters** – drained; place in proper container
